Knights Course - Local Rules

1. **Out of Bounds** (rule 27)
 - (a) On or beyond any walls or fences bounding the course.
 - (b) Beyond any line of white stakes bounding the course.
 - (c) When playing the 12th hole beyond the line of white stakes on the right of the hole.
 - (d) On or over the tarmac to the right and behind the 18th hole.
 - (e) On or over the wall bounding the patio in front of the clubhouse.
2. **Water Hazards** (rule 26)
 - (a) Areas marked with yellow stakes are water hazards.
 - (b) Areas marked with red stakes are lateral water hazards.
3. **Ground Under Repair** (rule 25)
 - (a) Areas marked with GUR or enclosed with a blue line.
 - (b) All newly turfed areas.
 - (c) Significant ruts made by vehicle tyres (not feint impressions).
4. **Obstructions** (rule 24)
Immovable
 - (a) All artificially surfaced roads, paths, open or gravel drains, aeration holes, cores and drainage slits, wire tree support stays, compost tree surrounds, the steps leading to the bunkers on the 16th hole and the gravel areas to the left of the first tee.
 - (b) All fixed sprinkler heads and irrigation controls.
 - (c) (Except when playing the hole) the white stakes defining the internal out of bounds on the 12th Hole.
 - (d) All seats, notice boards, ball washers, bins, shelters and yardage markers.
 - (e) The stone culvert at the 17th hole.**Movable**- Stones in bunkers.
Note- the boulders on the course are to be treated as integral parts of the course.
5. **Protection of Young Trees**
If a tree, less than two club lengths in height, or any tree supported by wire stays interferes with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball **must** be lifted and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b (Immovable Obstruction).
6. **Any Temporary Local Rule Defined on the Noticeboard**
Penalty for breach of a local rule
Match Play - loss of hole / Stroke Play - 2 strokes
7. **Pace of Play**
Each group, especially whilst playing from the black tees, should endeavour to display courtesy to others whilst maintaining a reasonable pace.
