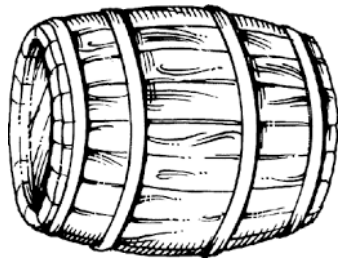

Whisky Region Traits

Highland

The Highlands are the largest region for whisky production which were traditionally peated but now less so. Nowadays they are more full bodied with deeper notes of spice.

Speyside

Speyside is the undisputed centre of whisky in Scotland, it boasts the highest concentration of distilleries - more than half of all distilleries in Scotland are found in this region. Speyside whiskies are thought to be the most complex and are known for their sweetness and elegant flavours.

Campbeltown

This was once the whisky capital of Scotland, now only three Distilleries are currently open. This whisky is peaty, salty with a briny character.

Islay

Islay whiskies are well known for their salty, smoky flavours which comes from the strong Atlantic gusts and the peat fuel commonly used across the island.

Lowland

Lowland whisky comes from the most southern parts of Scotland. They are generally lighter and fresher in colour and body than their counterparts – and they are also particularly fragrant with floral and grassy flavours.
